Illustrative example - not your figures

You 60%

Your spouse 40%

Estimated range 55/45 to 65/35, with the reasoning, the factors that moved it, and the case law behind it.

How to start

- 1 **Go to** smartjudge.ai on your phone or computer.
- 2 **Create an account.** Sign in with Google, Apple or Facebook, or use an email address and password. You do not need to give your name, and if you prefer to stay anonymous you can use a made-up email address - just keep the login somewhere safe.
- 3 **Answer the questions** at your own pace. Your progress saves automatically, there is help beside every question, and estimates are fine where you do not have an exact figure. You can come back and update anything later.
- 4 **Read your report.** Download it, email it to yourself, or share it with your mediator if you choose to. It is yours to keep.
